1. EPICUR Seed Funding Scope

- Foster **collaborative joint research projects**;
- Create **one-year joint research projects** between researchers affiliated to the EPICUR partner institutions;
- Stimulate synergies between **teaching & research**;
- Offer a **financial support mechanism** to researchers.

2. Eligibility: Type of funded activities

Activities that can be funded:

- Scientific activities to prepare **pilot studies** or research, establish **proof of concepts**;
- Activities to **initiate a research cooperation**:
 - Meetings;
 - Seminars;
 - Workshops.
- Activities related to developing a **future funding application**;
- **Joint learning activities** that will be offered in the framework of EPICUR.

2. Eligibility: Type of costs covered

The Seed Funding grant money can be used to cover **costs** related to **developing a future collaborative project** and **proposal writing**:

- freeing time to make pilot studies or research;
- travel to initiate cooperation and meetings;
- proposal writing;
- use research equipment;
- communication & dissemination;
- other costs to prepare the project/ build the research collaboration.

2. Eligibility: Consortium

- Only researchers **affiliated to the EPICUR partner universities** can join;
- Projects should have at least **3 partners** from **3 different EPICUR countries**;
- The projects should identify:
 - 1 lead Principal investigator (PI) for the project;
 - 1 Co-lead Principal investigator;
 - 1 Principal investigator for each participating partner institution.
- Participation of **R2- and R3-level ECRs** is encouraged but not required;
- External Higher Education Institutions cannot participate in the initial proposal but are welcome to join the consortium at a later stage (the scheme aims to foster and support inter-alliance collaboration)
- Exceptions: the University of **Amsterdam**, the University of **Pablo Olavide** (Spain), the University **Roma Tre** (Italy), and the University of **Basel** (Switzerland) without funding.
- External Partners (eg. Industrials, companies, public administrations, NGOs) are permitted but cannot be project lead or receive any EPICUR funding.

2. Eligibility: Expected impact

Two specific outcomes are expected from all projects:

- The project group must submit a **proposal for external funding** (Horizon Europe, Cofund, ...) **no later than 12 months after completing the Seed Funding project.**
- **A joint learning activity, (minimum of 6 hours),** must be offered in the framework of EPICUR either during the lifetime of the seed funding project or up to 6 months after its end. The activity can be developed as curricular or co-curricular offerings, as:
 - Courses;
 - Learning pathway
 - Summer schools;
 - Seminars;
 - Workshops;
 - Master classes;
 - Pop-up courses;
 - Conferences, etc.

2. Eligibility: Duration

- Projects can run for a period of **up to 12 months**;
- Projects can start **from January 2026**;
- An extension of maximum 12 months is possible if a justified request is received at least three months before the initial project period closes.

3. Budget

- Applicants can only be awarded funding from their **own affiliated university**.
- The final funding amount for each project will be allocated based on the **results of the scientific evaluation score** and the **total budget** available at each partner institution. The Evaluation Committee has the right to reduce amounts awarded.
- Available budget per institution:

4. Schedule

2026 Call for proposals	
Call open:	29th April 2026
Deadline for submission:	15 September 2026 – 23:59 CET
Evaluation process:	Mid-September – October 2026 → 4-step evaluation process
Expected results:	December 2026

5. Application Process & Documents

The project proposals must be submitted via the **SEED FUNDING file link** based at the University of Strasbourg: <https://seafire.unistra.fr/u/d/23f673afad1943528a77/>

The following **documents** should be submitted in one folder labelled « *PROJECTname_CoordinatingInstitution* » :

- Call document;
- Application form (template);
- Budget form (template);
- Letter of intent (template) – 1 from each partner combined into one pdf.

6. Evaluation & Selection process

The proposed projects will go through a **4-step evaluation/selection process**:

Evaluation & Selection Process	
1. Eligibility Check	Admissibility check (Administrative and Budget check) by the Alliance Coordination Office.
2. Scientific Review	Scientific evaluation by at least 2 academic peers exterior to the project coming from different EPICUR partner universities.
3. Evaluation Committee	Selection of recommended proposals to be funded, based on score and budget, with institutional representatives and members of the Research and Transfer (RTCOM) and Education Committee (ECOM).
4. Executive Board	The recommendations will be validated by the Executive Board.

The selection criteria for the scientific evaluation are the following:

Academic Quality	Max. 40 points
Research Quality	Max. 30 points
Educational Activity Quality	Max. 10 points
Scope and Project Activities	Max. 30 points
Relevance to EPICUR Strategy	Max. 10 points
Involvement of multiple Universities	Max. 5 points
Interdisciplinarity	Max. 5 points
Involvement of Early Career Researchers	Max. 5 points
Balance of activities between partners	Max. 5 points
Impact and Sustainability	Max. 30 points
Potential for external funding	Max. 10 points
Sustainability	Max. 10 points
Citizen Science Initiatives	Max. 5 points
Impact on students	Max. 10 points
Total	Max. 100 points

7. Payments, Implementation & Reporting

Payment arrangements:

- The selected projects can be awarded **up to a maximum of 150.000 EUR**;
- The final funding amount will be allocated based on the scientific evaluation score and total budget available at each partner institution;
- All payments will be made from each partner institution to their affiliated researchers.

Implementation arrangements:

- Project leads to be supported by their **Institutional contacts**;
- Further details given after project selection.

Reporting:

- Short **progress report** (After the end of the first 6-month period);
- Virtual **90-minute mid-term evaluation meeting** (Month 7 or 8);
- **Final project report** (end of the project +1 month).
